Front axle:

27.3.1. General description

Front axle:

23.1. Engine

23.1.2. Exhaust system

...The bracket (7) for the exhaust manifold, the corresponding bolts (8) and the clamp (9) are no longer required to fasten the exhaust manifold to the engine. These components must be removed when participating in PCCB events. Due to manufacturing reasons, new engines will continue to be supplied with the bracket. The mentioned parts should also be removed from new engines.
